

Uttarayani Activities in the Month of June 2019

Honourable Members a brief on our activities during the month of June 2019 is given below for the info of all members:

1. A delegation met the Members of Parliament and handed over to them a list of various projects with brief description of each project to be undertaken by them and followed up with various Ministries. These included projects related to air and rail connectivity; agriculture; water conservation, river rejuvenation and ground water recharge; healthcare and medical camps; opening of APS in Pauri and Uttarkashi; education and skill development etc.
